


Double Nomination!

A Decade of Kynren

We are proud to have been involved with Kynren for many years now. Southern Green started work on Kynren in April 2014 and involvement expanded to include LVIA, landscape masterplanning, public consultation, detailed design and implementation. We have also been involved in further stages of development as the park has expanded to include exciting day park attractions. The Kynren night show attracts a packed audience of around 8000 people at capacity for each show, and visitor numbers are expected to increase as the park expands and diversifies further, with 'Kynren – The Storied Lands', a brand-new historical theme park located within the broader Kynren Park in Bishop Auckland.
